A preposition is used before a noun or pronoun to show its relation with some other word in a sentence.

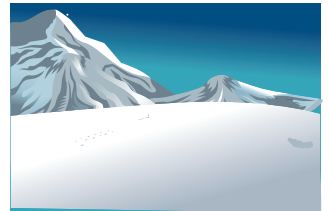
Fill in the blanks with suitable prepositions.
