An imperative sentence gives an order, request or advice.
It is used to ask people to do things or to give suggestions.
It is closed with a full stop (.)

Please accept my gift. [✓]



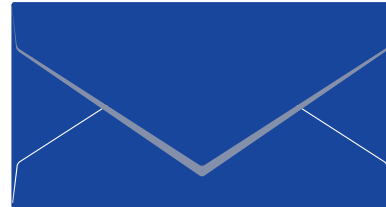
I want to give a gift. [X]
