An interrogative sentence helps to ask for something and ask a question. It ends with a question mark (?)

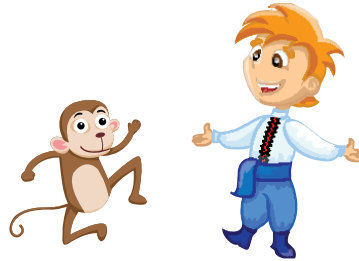
