FORMATION OF PAST TIME VERBS

- 1) Usually, past time verbs are formed by the addition of '-ed' to the base form of verb.
- 2) Some past time verbs are formed by internal change of vowel of base form verb.
- 3) Some verbs of past tense are formed in an irregular way.
- 4) Some verbs have same form in the base form as well as past time.

| Play | <u>Played</u> | Add - ed to form past. |
| Ring | <u>Rang</u> | Change of internal vowel. |

| Hit | <u>Hit</u> | Same verb in base form and past tense. |
