VOCABULARY (AFFIXES, PREFIXES & SUFFIXES)

Affix: An affix may be a letter or group of letters added to the beginning or end of a word. Affixes change the meaning of root words and help in the formation of new words. Affix may either serve as prefix or suffixes.

Example: Displease, Helpful

Prefix: It is a letter or group of letters added to the beginning of a word to get a new word with different meaning.

Example: Un + happy = Unhappy

Suffix: It is a letter or group of letters added to the end of a word to change the word into a different word with new meaning.

Example: Care + less = Careless
