1. a) Jack says that the expressions $11-9$ and $12-9$ are equal. But Jill says that they are not equal. Who is right?
b) Jill says that the expressions 14-7 and 11-4 are equal. Jack says that they are not equal. Who is right.
c) Jack says that to solve $12-9$, I can take 1 from 12 and give it to 9 to make it 10 . So, 12 - 9 is equal to 11 - 10. Jill thinks Jack made a mistake. Who is correct?
d) Jack and Jill are trying to find several subtraction number sentences that start with number larger than 10 and always have an answer of 5 . Help them figure out the number sentences. They started the first one.
