## SUBTRACTION WORD PROBLEMS

Read the math story and use drawing or number bond to show how you know who is right.

1. a) Alice says that the expressions $12-3$ and $14-5$ are equal. Jim says that they are not equal. Who is right?
b) Jim says that the expressions $13-6$ and $16-8$ are equal. Alice says that they are not equal. Who is right.
c) Alice says that to solve $17-6$, I can take 4 from 17 and give it to 6 to make it 10. So, $17-6$ is equal to $14-10$. Jim thinks Alice made a mistake. Who is correct?
d) Alice and Jim are trying to find several subtraction number sentences that start with number larger than 10 and always have an answer of 8 . Help them figure out the number sentences. They started the first one.
