c) Rose says that to solve $18-5$, I can take 5 from 18 and give it to 5 to make it 10. So, 18 - 5 is equal to $13-10$. Elise thinks Rose made a mistake. Who is correct?
d) Rose and Elise are trying to find several subtraction number sentences that start with number larger than 10 and always have an answer of 9 . Help them figure out the number sentences. They started the first one.
