SUBTRACTIONS

Read the following word problems and then observe the students works. Select the student work that correctly matches the story.

1) David brought 12 mangoes in a basket. He kept 9 mangoes on in table. How many mangoes are left in the basket?

Select the student work that correctly matches the story.

a)

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 - 9 \\ \swarrow \quad \searrow \\ 10 \quad 2 \\ 10 - 9 = 1 \\ 1 + 2 = 3 \end{array}$$

b)

Two rows of 5 mangoes each, with 3 mangoes below them. = 3

c)

$$\begin{array}{r} 12 - 9 \\ \swarrow \quad \searrow \\ 10 \quad 3 \\ 10 - 9 = 1 \\ 1 + 3 = 4 \end{array}$$

d)

⑨ 1 mango with a bracket labeled 1, and 2 mangoes with a bracket labeled 2. = 3

e)

Two rows of 5 mangoes each, with 1 mango to the right of the second row. = 1
2 mangoes = 2
1 + 2 = 3

f)

Two rows of 5 mangoes each, with 2 mangoes below. = 2
