$$10 - 6 = 4$$

$$11 - 4 = 7$$

$$4 + 1 = 5$$

d)

$$\begin{array}{c} 11 \\ \underbrace{\hspace{0.5cm}} \\ 1 \end{array}$$

$$4 + 1 = 5$$

e)

$$\begin{array}{c} 11 - 6 \\ \swarrow \quad \searrow \\ 3 \quad 3 \end{array}$$

$$11 - 3 = 8$$

$$8 + 3 = 11$$
