**ADDITION WORDS PROBLEMS (ADDING 2 NUMBERS)**

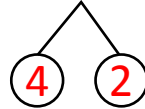
Change the picture to make a ten. Write the easier number sentence and solve.

Example:

- 1) Charles made some sweets. He ate 6 sweets and kept the remaining 6 sweets in a box. How many sweets charles made?



$$\underline{6} + \underline{6} = \underline{12}.$$

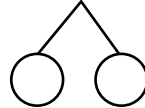


$$10 + \underline{2} = \underline{12}.$$
