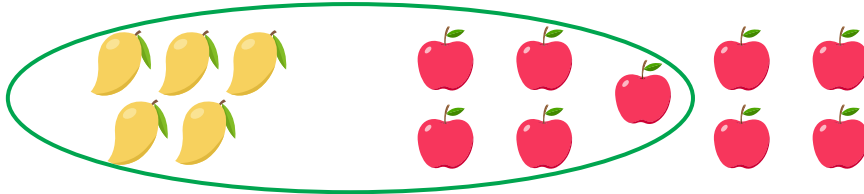

There are 5 mangoes and 9 apples in a room. How many fruits are there in the room?

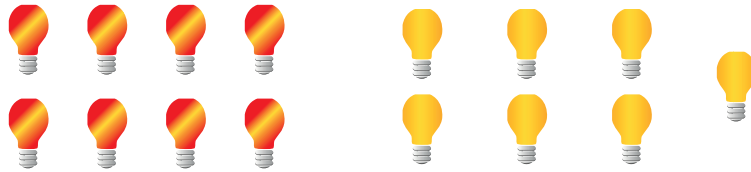


$$\underline{5} + \underline{9} = \underline{14}$$
