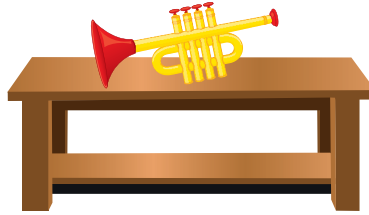
SENTENCES (IDENTIFY SENTENCES)

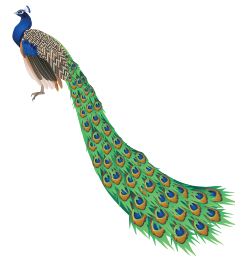
