PUNCTUATION (USE OF COMMAS)

Comma is used to separate two clauses with small pause. It is used to separate the direct speech pointed in the quotation marks from the speaker / subject.

Note commas at the places where pause is needed and shade the first part / clause / speaker of a sentence in green.

Examples:

- i) If you work hard, you will do well in the examinations.
- ii) Arnold replied, "I have no words to speak".
- 1) Having done his homework, Smith went to play.
- 2) If you have an extra pen, please give it to my friend.
- 3) When we are ready, you will start the game.
- 4) "Think well to solve the problem", said the teacher.
