SUBTRACTIONS

Solve the problems by counting on and using a number bond to take from ten.

Example:

Ron has 17 balloons in his hand. He left 9 balloons in the air. How many balloons are left with Ron now?

$$17 - 9 = \underline{8}.$$

 \end{array}$$

$$10 - 9 = 1$$

$$1 + 7 = 8$$

Ron has 8 balloons left.

- 1) Alice has 13 barbies. She made hairstyles to 9 barbies. How many barbies are still remaining to do hairstyles?

$$13 - 9 = \underline{\quad}.$$

 barbies are left with out hairstyles.

- 2) John made 15 cupcakes. He gave 9 cupcakes to friends. How many cupcakes are left with John?

$$15 - 9 = \underline{\quad}.$$

John is left with cupcakes.

- 3) Rachel has 12 apples. She gave 9 apples to her mother. How many apples are left with Rachel?

$$12 - 9 = \underline{\quad}.$$

Rachel is left with apples.
