



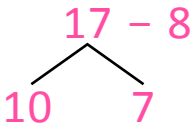

Example:

Micah added 8 coins to her coins collection. If Micah now have 17 coins, how many coins she had. before?



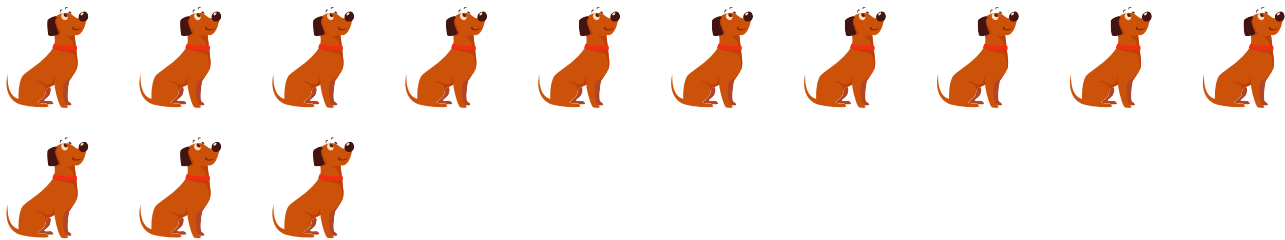
$$10 - 8 = 2$$

$$2 + 7 = 9$$

Mathematical statement:  $17 - 8 = 9$ .

Micah had 9 stamps.

1) Alice counted 6 dogs in the morning. In the evening she counted 13 dogs. How many dogs come extra?



2) There are some children playing in the playground. 5 children are playing hide and seek. If there are 12 children in the playground, how many children are not playing hide and seek?
