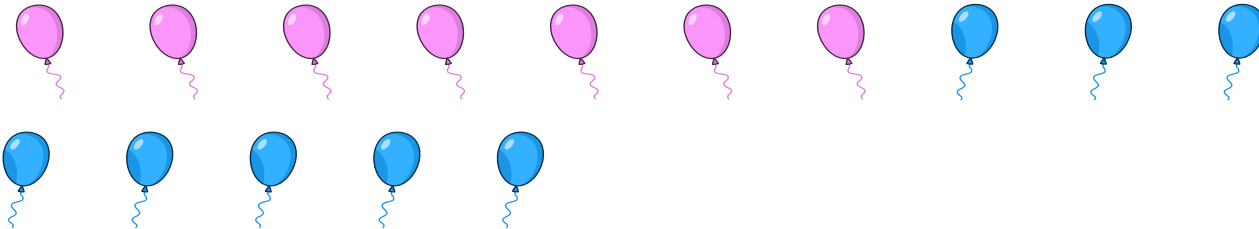
SUBTRACTION WORD PROBLEMS
