

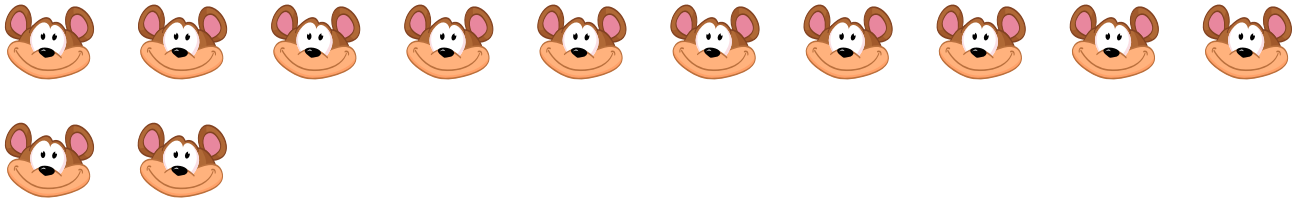

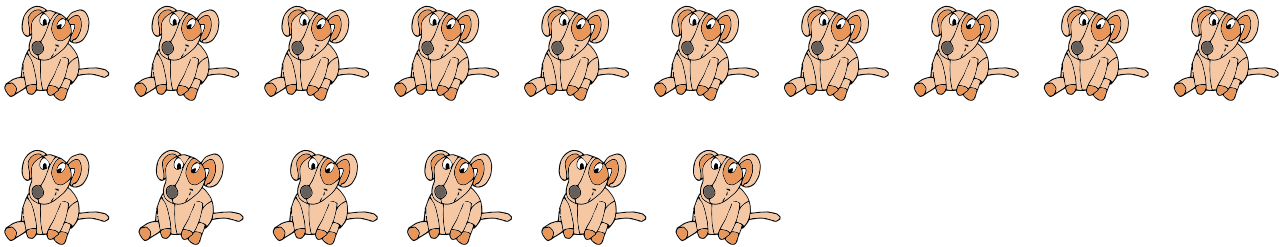
## SUBTRACTION WORD PROBLEMS
