MONEY WORD PROBLEMS

Addition with coins in different situations.

Example:

Andrew buys a chocolate for 2 dimes. Toby buys a muffins for 1 dime. How much money do they spend in all?

Andrew buys a chocolates = 20 cents.

Toby buys a muffins = 10 cents.

30 cents

Andrew and Toby together spent 30 cents.

1) Ben buys a pencil for 15 cents and an eraser for 10 cents. How much money did Ben spent?

Pencil costs = ___ cents.

Eraser costs = cents.

Ben spent ___ cents.

2) George bought two ice creams. Each ice cream costs 20 cents. How much amount did George paid for the ice cream?

One ice cream = ___ cents.

Toby buys a chocolates = ___ + ___ = ___ cents.

George paid ___ cents.

3) Anton buys five balloons for 10 cents and Jill buys two toys for 50 cents. How much money did they spent in all?

Five balloons = ___ cents.

Two toys = cents.

Anton and Jill spent ___ cents in all.
