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## SUBTRACTION

Word problems subtraction taking as base 10.

## Example:

John has 100 sticks. Alice has 60 sticks. Alice wants to have the same number of stickers as John. How many more stickers does Alice need?
Solution:
John has 100 sticks.
Alice has 60 sticks.
(Alice wants to have the more number of stickers as John)
Alice need more stickers $=\underline{100}-\underline{60}=\underline{40}$.


1) In a class there are 80 students. 50 students went out. How many students are still remaining in the class room?

## Solution:

Number of students $=$ $\qquad$ .

Number of students went out $=$ $\qquad$ .

Remaining students in the class room $=$ $\qquad$ - $\qquad$ $=$ $\qquad$ .

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
