Dictionary serves as the best reference material to know the correct meaning, pronunciation and spelling of a word. The words in a dictionary are arranged in alphabetical order based on first, second, third and other letters. The words noted on the top of a page in a dictionary are called guide words. The first two letters are common for all words given in each row. Look at the third letter and indicate the sequence of words alphabetically through numbers. Use a beginner dictionary and verify your answers.
