PRONOUNS

Personal pronouns refer to specific persons or things. They stand for three persons.

First person: person or persons speaking. Second person: person or persons spoken to. Third person: person / thing / persons / things spoken of. A personal pronouns used must have the same number, gender and person as the noun it stands for personal pronouns may be used as subject / object in a sentence.
