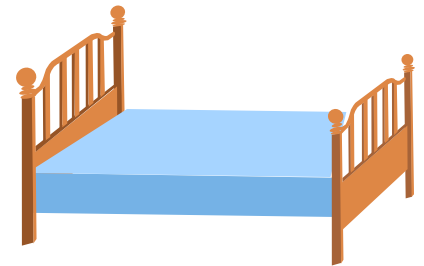
PAST TENSE OF IRREGULAR VERBS

Some verbs form their past tense in irregular way. They can't form their past tense in a simple / regular way. They don't follow the conventional rule of adding – ed at the end to form past tense. They adapt sneaky or tricky ways for the formation of past and as a result these verbs completely change and look different in their past forms. Hence they are called irregular verbs. Some irregular verbs also follow some pattern.
